

Faith Bible Church Membership Policy

1. **Introduction:** The Membership Application process is not designed to guarantee or certify a person's salvation. Only God can know, for sure, a person's status before Him. This application is made generally available to anyone who is interested in membership. After completing the Membership Matters Class, the applicant completes a Membership Application. The applicant certifies by signature that he/she has read and agrees to the provisions of the Statement of Faith/Doctrinal Statement and the By Laws. The application is given to an FBC elder, and a meeting is set-up to hear the applicant's testimony and to discuss any questions or concerns by either party.
2. **Purpose:** To gather information to assist applicants and elders prepare for the membership process.
3. **Policy:**
 - 3.1. The elders receive and review the membership applications of each person desiring to become an official member of Faith Bible Church.
 - 3.2. The elders meet with each applicant to hear his/her testimony and discuss any questions about doctrine, ministry, and membership responsibilities.
 - 3.3. The applicant indicates, by submitting the application, agreement with church policies in general and specifically the leadership of the elders and submission to the Church Discipline process.
 - 3.4. If the applicant is accepted by the elders, the elders present him/her to the congregation at a subsequent Sunday morning meeting to inform the membership that the applicant is joining. The membership of the church that is present at the meeting affirms acceptance of mutual responsibilities toward and from the new member by verbal assent.
